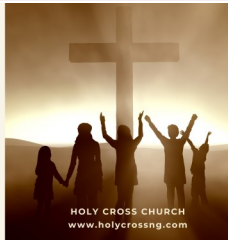


**Little Ones Word**

On **Wednesday evening 10 June 2020** we will be **Livestreaming our Weekday Mass at 7:00 pm**. Prior to the mass we will be praying the **Rosary starting at 6:30 pm**. Please join us in praying to our Blessed Mother for an end to this pandemic.

On **Friday 12 June 2020** from 6 pm to 7 pm we will be having a Parking lot **Eucharistic Adoration (weather permitting)** with **Benediction**. A parking lot attendant will instruct you where you may park. Bring your cellphones or laptop or tablets. We hope to have an audio zoom connection. More details will be given later in the week.

While Eucharistic Adoration is going on in the parking lot, those wishing to go to confession can drive up to the portico and roll down your window. Of course you should be alone in the vehicle. I will be hearing confessions from 6 to 7 pm or extended as necessary.

Our annual memorial mass is fast approaching at the end of June. At this mass we remember in a special way those who have died in the last year (*i.e.* ~ *March 2019 to present*). Their names will appear on a slide before the mass begins to livestream.

Our small group homily series session is cancelled for this week, but will be back next week. Next weekend we will be wrapping up this homily series.
