

Face Masks

Everyone must wear a face mask in the church. Face masks are now mandatory in indoor public spaces to stop the spread of COVID-19, this includes all worship spaces and churches. This order was issued for Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit this week.

There will be exceptions to the requirement, for instance children under the age of two, or people who are medically or physically unable to put on a mask. Officials will rely on the good faith of individuals who say they are unable to wear a mask. Note that wearing a face mask is in addition to our social distancing.

Parishioners should bring their own face mask. Should some parishioners not be aware of the order and not be prepared, we have a limited supply of masks which we can make available.

All those involved in ministries, must wear a mask except when they are required to speak or sing to fulfil their ministry.

Changes in the Livestream Mass & the Saturday Evening Mass

Prior to us opening up to the public for Mass, we were able with my private Mass to present online the Mass as you would have experienced it here at Holy Cross on any given Sunday prior to Covid-19 (hymns were sung in full, all the readings, the creed, longer homilies or homily series, sung eucharistic prayer etc.).

Upon opening up to the public we followed the Worship Safe directives from the Archdiocese and all the conditions of opening up to the public. Those restrictions changed the experience of Mass for those present in our church and also those joining us online. We have now had two weekends with this new format and have had a chance to examine the attendance data; the ministry schedule challenges; the in church and online experience; and some of the physical distancing challenges (especially at the 9 am mass upstairs). This week we are now required to wear masks and with the recent heat wave it all adds to the mix of issues.

After consultation with a few key people, looking at the data and meeting with the musicians, I have made the following decisions:

1. Beginning this Saturday, we will be Live Streaming the Saturday evening Mass at 5:00 pm. You may still view the mass on Sunday, or anytime at your convenience on Facebook, YouTube or our webpage. We will discontinue the Live Streaming of the 9 am mass effective this Sunday.
2. Beginning on Saturday 18 July 2020 the Saturday evening mass will become my private mass, **not opened to the public**. This Mass will be Live Streamed and will be similar to the Masses we had prior to opening.

The Sunday masses at 9 am and 11 am will continue to be open to the public observing all the restrictions in place for public gatherings as outlined by the health unit and the Worship Safe guidelines of the Archdiocese.
