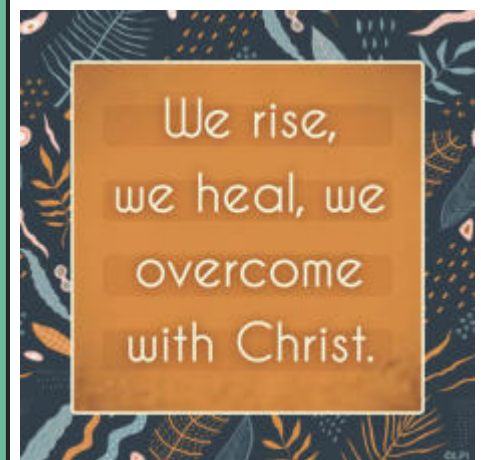
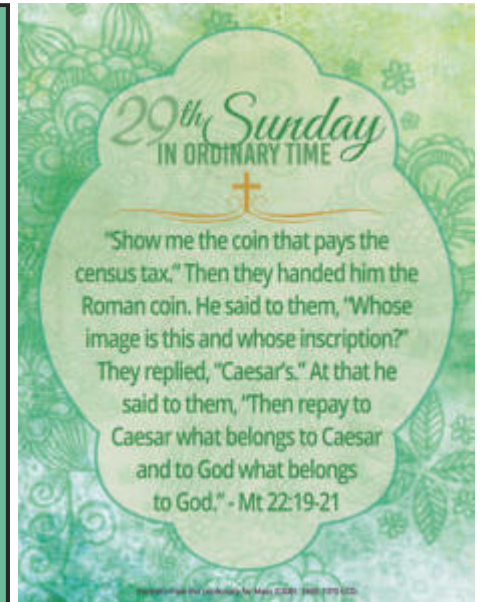

MQSCA News

Last week our students completed the Fall Measures of Academic Progress, or MAP test. Our at home learners came into the building for the first time on Monday & Tuesday to complete their MAP test and our in person learners completed it when they returned on Wednesday. The MAP test is particularly insightful this year, as many students not only experienced a 'summer slide', but also a 'COVID slide' due to the unexpected shut down in March. The information gained from the MAP test will help teachers personalize learning and target instructional needs of our students. We will continue to use the MAP test and data throughout the year to track student growth.

of all things visible and invisible.

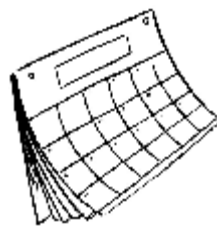
I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God,

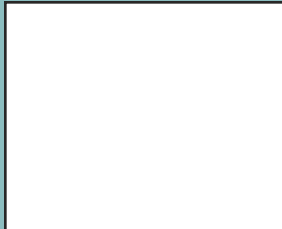
