At that time there shall arise Michael, the great prince. Even under persecution, the people should continue to hope for deliverance from God. The Archangel Michael was considered the special protector of Israel.

READING II: HEB 10:11-14 ,18

Jesus has made one offering for all our sins. The repeated annual sacrifices of the high priest is replaced with the "once and for all" sacrifice of Christ. This passage both declares a new covenant and describes the act of atonement and sin offering that God both provides and accepts.

GOSPEL: MK 13:24-32

Watch for the signs of the coming of the kingdom. Mark contrasts Jesus' condemnation of those who practice religion for show with the widow who offers God all she has.

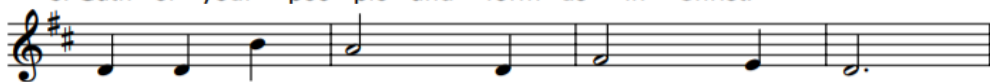
