Dear St. Agnes Family,

It is good to be writing for the bulletin once again! You all have been held close in the prayers of Fr. Eric and of myself. While missing those of you not able to be with us for good reason today, it is also a joy to come back together in worship once again in our Church. As we celebrated our first Liturgy since March 15th at our daily Mass on May 27th, I had an exhilarating feeling as well as a peaceful feeling come over me. I realized how the beautifully mystical Body of Christ, the Eucharistic community that we are, adapted to keep us together and united these past few months. And now we find ourselves in this time of transition, each of us in a different place relating to coming back to the Church building. Things will be a bit different; they will be clumsy as we stay vigilant to the safety of all, but the movements and graces of our Eucharistic celebration steadies us and continues on. It is good to see many of you and those who have remained at home are ever so close at heart.

On another note, I echo Archbishop Thompson in light of the recent incidents of racial hatred and the response to them across our country. "As we celebrate Pentecost this (past) weekend, I call upon all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis to pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to heal the brokenness that has so deeply wounded our society. Let us also pray for peaceful protests that truly seek healing against the evil of racism". I offer the prayer of Saint Francis to pray whenever we feel lost in the confusion and uncertainty of what to do, letting its words sink in, allowing them to form and inform us and allowing the voice of God to enter our hearts and move us to some action in our lives that brings about justice, charity and hope.
