Greetings St. Agnes Family,

I had someone ask if RCIA is for someone who is already a baptized Christian. Good question! The Rite of Christian Initiation is for those who are unbaptized, referred to as Catechumens. Those who are already baptized, after a period of preparation “come into full communion with the Church” and are referred to as Candidates. Here is an explanation from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website:

Coming into full communion with the Catholic Church describes the process for entrance into the Catholic Church for already baptized Christians. In most cases, these individuals make a profession of faith but are not baptized again. To prepare for this reception, the people, who are called Candidates, usually participate in a formation program to help them understand and experience the teachings and practices of the Catholic Church. The Candidates may be received into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil or at another Sunday during the year depending on pastoral circumstances and readiness of the Candidate.

We welcome anyone who is already a baptized Christian and interested in preparing to come into full communion with the Church – please join us! We will begin classes on September 13th, meeting on Sundays at 9:30, between the two Masses, downstairs in the Parish Hall.

On another note, just an FYI to keep you all in the loop, our collections have dropped as July rolled around. Our new fiscal year began July 1st so we would like to get off to a good start! We continue to put the collection basket at the back of Church in three places, or you can continue to mail in as well. Arch Indy continues to offer an online option; however, we look forward soon to offering our own online giving that Becky is working on! It’s great ~ More to come!
