When I look and reflect on today's readings, I think immediately of my dear priest friend. When his elderly mother could no longer care for herself, he had to place her in an assisted living facility. One horrible night she woke and found a man stealing from her nightstand. He needed money for drugs. He murdered her to keep her silent. The man was caught and sentenced to prison. The priest was brokenhearted and angry. He found out where the man was incarcerated and went to visit. For the next 20 years my friend visited this man at Christmas and Easter to hear his confession and bring him the Holy Eucharist. They became friends. How was this possible? No matter... **this is precisely what God wants us to do.**

*I fear we have slowly become a vindictive nation and people. We must love as God loves. Jesus himself said to his tormentors, "Forgive them Lord, for they know not what they do". To practice holiness, goodness and love is NOT easy. We must **radically** love those who hurt us. Is it possible? Yes, with God's help we know that all things are possible.*

Fasting and Abstinence — Catholics abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all the Fridays of Lent. On a day of fasting, eat only one full meal; you may also eat two partial meals. Everyone age 14 and older is bound by the law of abstinence. Fasting is required of people 18 to 59. Catholics younger and older than that need not fast, and any person with medical issues is exempt from fasting.

Wider Catholic Community News (cont'd)

Villanova Preparatory School — Villanova has made changes to its Merit Scholarship program. It has been expanded to include students who score at or above the 90th percentile on the High School Placement Test (HSPT). The value of these scholarships has been increased to 60% of the day student tuition for students scoring in the 99th and 98th percentile, 50% for students scoring in the 97th through 95th percentile, and 40% for student scoring in the 94th through 90th percentile. For students scoring below the 90th percentile, Villanova will continue to offer its Augustinian Scholarships which are awarded to students who show promise in a particular field or area of focus. **www.villanovaprep.org**.
