Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

We're more than a month into our semester, and much has happened. We've had a lot of great events, meeting new students, going on hikes, participating in Bible Studies, and much prayer, adoration, and fellowship. This coming week is one of our semester's highlights with our first annual Great Debate. Join us Wednesday night at 7:00 p.m. at the University Inn for what is sure to be a great event, both in its content as we hear a debate on the authenticity of the Shroud of Turin, as well as the witness to healthy dialogue and discussion of differences of opinions, which is so sorely needed in our world today.

Next week, we begin our religious education program, which will be every 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month, from Oct. to Mar., immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass.
