### Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It's hard to believe that we're already into October! It's been such a full and busy semester, and it's still far from over. Weekly events continue, such as our Monday night Healing Series and Bible Studies. Later this month, we'll welcome back to campus Paul Darrow to give his Testimony to Love on Oct 27th in the Vandal Ballroom at 7:00 p.m. Mark your calendars for this important event!

This past week we had our first annual Great Debate. It was a huge success. Thank you to all who joined us, in person and online. I shared at the beginning of the event the reason for the Great Debate and our mission:

*Part of the mission of St. Augustine's Catholic Center is to support and witness to the revealed presence of God in all aspects of life, which is especially important at a university setting amongst those asking big questions and making consequential decisions, not only for their own life, but for the common good, for the welfare of society in general. The great, 19<sup>th</sup> c. English saint and scholar, John Henry Newman, observed in his third discourse on the 'Idea of a University', that "Religious Truth is not only a portion, but a condition of general knowledge. To blot it out is nothing short, if I may so speak, of unraveling the web of University Teaching." In other words, to truly be effective, to truly promote the common good, higher education must recognize the role of God as foundational for all knowledge and learning. Our annual debates over the coming years, besides our many other activities, seek to give voice to this Truth, that God underpins every one of our lives, and should propel our lives, as he draws us toward himself in the fullness of Truth. Besides this fundamental mission, our students, our society, desperately need to see examples of healthy, well-articulated argumentation, to see that people with differing views can share a room and a stage in peace and respect.*

Gratefully, the debate went as planned, and we were given a powerful example of respectful dialogue.

This weekend we kick off our religious education, beginning preparation for the sacraments of 1st Communion, 1st Confession, and Confirmation. We'll meet the first and third Sundays of the month through March. You can mark your calendars now to celebrate 1st Communion on April 11th, the 2nd Sunday of Easter, often called Divine Mercy Sunday. 1st Reconciliation and Confirmation dates will be announced later.
