Robert Spitzer, S.J., Ph.D. Fr. Spitzer, formerly President of Gonzaga University, is President of The Magis Center for Faith and Reason (<https://magiscenter.com> and <https://crediblecatholic.com>). He is a high-energy speaker of formidable intellect with a broad and deep grasp of philosophy, science, and spirituality, having previously publically debated Stephen Hawking, among others. His presentation is titled "Called Out of Darkness." In contrast to the false cosmology presented and widely embraced by popular culture, Fr. Spitzer illuminates the fullness of Reality, in which we live, and the tools God has given us to deal with what is really real.
