## Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ February 14, 2021

### *One Body, One Spirit Stewardship Campaign*

#### Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Lent is upon us, and begins this Wednesday. We'll have a number of opportunities to receive ashes as usual, including at 7:15 a.m. (Mass), 12:30 p.m. (just distribution), and 5:30 p.m. (Mass). I'll also be in Potlatch at St. Mary's at 7:00 p.m. For the first time, we'll be offering confessions on Ash Wednesday, beginning at 4:00 p.m. in the main church. In case there's high demand, Fr. Mark Uhlenkott will also be here to hear confessions at the same time. Besides the normally scheduled times for confession throughout Lent, we'll have a penance service just before Easter as we did last Advent.

As we prepare to begin Lent, we should prayerfully reflect upon our spiritual life. It should be continually growing, deepening, and strengthening through various spiritual practices. These are broken down into three areas: prayer, almsgiving, and fasting. While these spiritual practices should be part of our life year-round, Lent is a time to be more rigorous as we prepare ourselves for the celebration of the great mysteries of Holy Week: the Institution of the Lord's Supper and our Lord's Crucifixion and Resurrection.

Our annual stewardship campaign is designed to help you make a plan for your spiritual life in concrete ways, through prayer, almsgiving, and fasting. We began the annual campaign last year and were happy with the initial success, both with the increased prayer, almsgiving, and fasting, as well as the number of those who chose to participate by returning a commitment form. Our goal, in particular for this year, is to have even more people fill out and turn in a commitment form. They'll be mailed this week to all of our parishioners and available next week at the door of the church for those who are able to join us in person for Mass. This week, you'll hear a couple of testimonies about what stewardship means, and next week we'll take a more concentrated look at living stewardship through our parish.

Our theme for our stewardship program this year is "One Body, One Spirit." Much more will be said about this in the next couple of weeks, but the main idea is that we are called to be one with God and each other. Especially in these difficult times, it's more important than ever to draw together in mutual support.
