Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Thank you to all who turned in commitment cards for our "One Body, One Spirit" stewardship campaign. If you haven't had a chance yet, it's not too late to put them in the offertory basket at Mass or mail them into the office. We've had a strong level of participation and will report trends and results as soon as they are processed.

Our campus ministry program is continuing to grow and serve our campus in a variety of ways. This past week, Eden Anderson, one of our second-year medical students, presented on fertility and the Catholic perspective to a large audience. We are also at a record number of FOCUS Bible studies, with 10 of our students leading their own Bible study, besides the missionaries who also lead Bible studies, and 90 of our students who have attended the Bible studies that are offered. Please continue to keep our missionaries and students in your prayers that we may evangelize more and more of our students!

After consulting with our parish's Pastoral Council and Finance Council, I've found someone to fill our Director of Development position that was vacated when Amy McNelly became our Executive Director last Fall. For clarity's sake, we're also changing the title to Director of Philanthropy. I'm excited to announce that John Pawelek will be returning to St. Augustine's this June to fill the role. John served as a FOCUS missionary here for 2 1/2 years and has since served as the FOCUS Team Director at the University of Washington. His wife Natalie served as Team Director on our campus last year. They know and love St. Augustine's well and will be a great resource for our parish. John is excited to advance our mission and help us to grow!

In the last couple of weeks, Bishop Peter has indicated his desire that we plan to stay in our current facilities as we grow and to renovate them to serve our needs. This has been an ongoing question for some time and it is nice to have a clearer path forward. There are many details to work out in regard to scope and design, which I'll discuss with the Pastoral Council this week. There'll be an inevitable capital campaign for our renovations this Summer and Fall, which will be one of John's primary tasks as he hits the ground running on his start day, June 7th.

Please pray for all of our parish as we continue to discern God's will of how to best serve our community, especially in regard to our facilities. There will be plenty of time for consultation and opportunity for feedback as the plans develop in the coming months.
