Read the psalm a second time out loud, speaking your prayer to God. Listen for what God says in response to you.

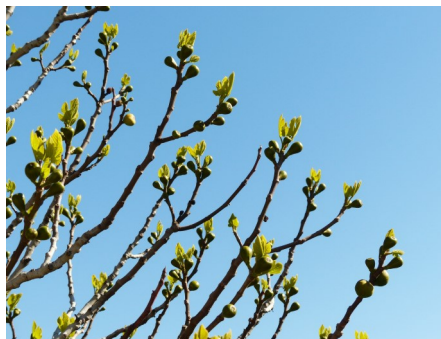
*Keep me safe, O God;
