Dear Kindergarten Parents,

If you are like me, you try to catch the summer school supply sales. And the sales are certainly out in full force right now! The following is a list of items that kindergarten children will need as we begin the school year:

- a **backpack** (large enough to carry folders, lunchbox and a water bottle) I find the small-ish backpacks do not work well.
- a **lunchbox**
- a **water bottle** that can be brought to school each day and refilled at home. We will not be using the water fountains at school this year.
- 2 **boxes of crayons** (24 count packs of Crayola crayons are best). We may need to replenish these a few times during the year, if you want to grab an extra pack or two while they are on sale!
- 2 **large glue sticks**
- 2 **pocket folders**, labeled with your child's name
- 2 boxes of **tissues**
- 1 roll of **paper towels**
- 2 containers of **anti-bacterial wipes** to use on desks
- 1 bottle of **hand sanitizer**
- 1 **hard sided plastic pencil box/case**. (Supplies for individual use will be kept in this case in your child's desk)

For Art with Ms. Murmann, in addition to some of the items above, she would like students to have the following items.

- A black sharpie marker
- A set of water-based markers- Mr Sketch 12 pack
- A box of cray-pas-8or 12 color set
- A box of colored pencils- 12 or 24 color set

Children will keep these supplies in their desk of individual use. Please label all items you send in. Extra items will be safely stored and available for your child as needed. From time to time I may ask for additional donations for class projects. However, the items on the list will help us get off to a great start to the school year. Thank you for your support.
