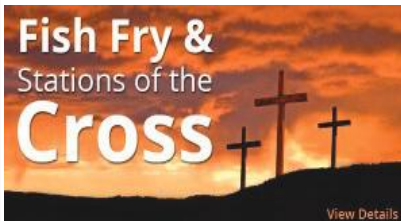

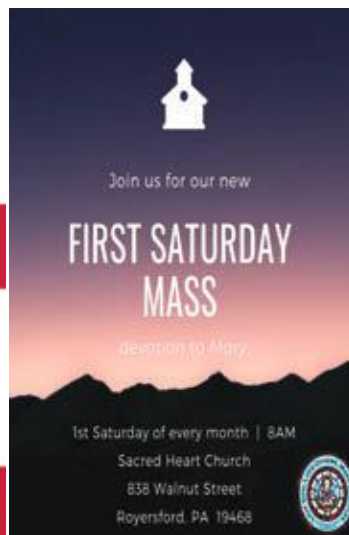

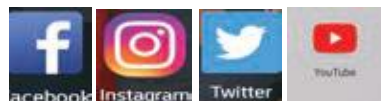

This Weekend's Second Collection will be for the Little Sisters of the Poor

The Little Sisters of the Poor are an order of Catholic nuns whose life's work is to serve the elderly poor. Now they have been forced to ask the Supreme Court for relief due to the government's refusal to exempt them from a regulation that makes them choose between their faith—which prohibits them from providing certain contraceptives—and continuing to pursue their religious mission.


SAINT OF THE DAY

March 3 - Saint Katharine Drexel founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament to minister primarily to Native and African Americans in the United States. She used much of her inherited wealth to support both the sisters and the ministry. She entered religious life as a Sister of Mercy before founding her new community which opened its first foundation in Santa Fe, New Mexico, in 1894.

March 4 - Saint Casimir was born into a noble family, and was himself in line to be king. Instead he opted for a life of prayer, and as a youth vowed perpetual chastity. Opposed by his family, Saint Casimir held fast to his ideals until his early death at the age of 25. In his native land and elsewhere, he is considered an example of perseverance.

March 7 - Saints Perpetua and Felicity - The Church faced persecutions early on in its history. Saints Perpetua and Felicity are two well-known names among the martyrs. While we don't know much about them, we do have Saint Perpetua's diary that gives a few facts about their last days.
