FROM THE SCHUMAKER'S BENCH

I am taking a break this week from the Works of Mercy series. It will resume next week.

This past Tuesday, early in the morning, an incident occurred at St Gregory with 4 young people in which one of our new TV's was stolen/damaged. I have reached out to the Hart Police Department as well as Superintendent Mark Platt to help with identifying the 4 individuals.

In the next few weeks, I intend to read out to Chief Salazar and seek his help with a safety assessment of our buildings. It is my hope that we will then move forward with making sure our buildings are secure so that this does not happen again. As I said to both the Pastoral and Finance Councils when I first arrived, gone are the days where all people understood that a church was a sacred place, and it was left alone. This is what prompted the addition of the new locks on the sacristy doors because I wanted to be proactive rather than reactive. In one of the videos, one of the persons tried opening the sacristy door and is hear saying, "oh, they lock this now."

I will also be reaching out to the Shelby Police Department to do the same at Our Lady of Fatima Church. It is unfortunate that we live in a world where this kind of thing happens, but I encourage you all to pray for these young people and for all others, that they may truly have an experience of God in their life which leads to the inner transformation St. Paul speaks of countless times in his letters.

UPDATES:

Roof work is almost complete at St. Gregory. The new clerestory windows were installed on Thursday and the project is still on track to be completed by November 12, so that we can return to the normal locations of all liturgies the weekend of November 14/15 (opening day).

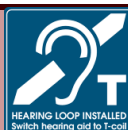
