## **R.C.I.A. (Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults) . . . Who is it for?**

- ◆ It is for those not baptized who desire to respond to God's invitation to eternal life both here and hereafter.
- ◆ It is for those already baptized, but not in the Catholic Church, who desire to respond to God's invitation to full and visible communion with the Church which He has established.
- ◆ It is for those already baptized in the Catholic Church, but not brought up in the practice of the Faith, who desire to respond to God's invitation to allow Him to bring completion what He has already begun.
- ◆ It is for members of the parish who desire to respond to God's invitation to return to the practice of the Faith.
- ◆ It is for members of the parish who desire to respond to God's invitation to refresh and renew on an adult level what was given to them as children.
- ◆ It is for members of the parish who desire to respond to God's invitation to deepen their own spirituality by involving and investing themselves in the lives and the spiritual journey of those whom God is drawing ever more closely to Himself.

In one way or another, it is for us all.

***A new session of R.C.I.A. will begin at OLG on Wednesday, September 10th at 7:00 p.m. in the Catholic Life Center and will meet on a weekly basis to explore the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church. During that time, participants prayerfully discern how the Lord is at work in their lives and how He might be leading them toward the Catholic faith. There are no strings attached. It is, as with Jesus' invitation to his followers, "come and see".***

**Baptisms:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated the third Sunday of each month after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Baptism classes for parents and godparents are held the first Monday of every month at 6:00 p.m. in the Catholic Life Center.

**Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick:** Those who are seriously ill should be given the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick as soon as possible. Communal celebrations are held during Advent and Lent.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Arrangements for weddings must be made at least six months ahead of time. A pre-marriage preparation program and individual counseling with the parish priest are required for all.

**House Calls:** Please notify the parish office of the names of any who desire to receive Holy Communion, the Sacrament of the Sick or the Sacrament of Reconciliation at home.

**St. Joseph Perpetual Adoration Chapel:** We welcome you to visit our chapel as a guest or a committed adorer. Call the parish office for questions or to sign up for an hour.
