

SSP SCHOOL ILLNESS PROTOCOL

If a student calls in sick, answers affirmatively to any of our health-screen questions, has a temperature over 100.4 degrees, or is sent home sick from school, they should be evaluated by their primary care provider for COVID-19 testing.

WAS A COVID-19 TEST PERFORMED?

NO EVALUATION / TEST WAS PERFORMED.

PRESUMED POSITIVE.

Student may return to school:

- After at least 14 calendar days from the start of illness **OR** with a doctor's note that a COVID-19 test is not warranted
AND
- Student has no fever over 100.4 (without fever-reducing meds) for at least 3 days
AND
- Student's symptoms are improving

YES. TEST WAS POSITIVE.

TESTED POSITIVE.

Student will isolate at home per public health guidelines. Student may return to school:

- After at least 14 calendar days from the start of illness
AND
- Student has no fever over 100.4 (without fever-reducing meds) for at least 3 days
AND
- Student's symptoms are improving

YES. TEST WAS NEGATIVE.

TESTED NEGATIVE OR OTHER ILLNESS DIAGNOSED*

Student may return to school according to school policies dictated by any diagnosed illness with proof of negative COVID-19 test.

* "Other illness" means either a test showed the student had a non-COVID-19 illness OR the student had symptoms consistent with a non-COVID-19 illness.
