### Pentecost Sunday

*There appeared to them tongues as of fire,  
which parted and came to rest on each one of them. — Acts 2:3*

### SEND OUR YOUR SPIRIT

Last week we heard that, following the Ascension, the disciples, Mary, and other followers of the Lord retreated to the upper room in prayer. This week we hear that, while praying in that room, the Holy Spirit comes upon them. Jesus' post-Resurrection promise, recounted in today's Gospel, is fulfilled: the power of the Holy Spirit comes upon Jesus' followers. Saint Paul tells us that all of us, in some way, are given gifts of the Holy Spirit, gifts that can be used to spread the Good News. Today is one of the Church's greatest festivals. Let us carry the refrain of the responsorial psalm with us throughout the coming week: "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth!" (Psalm 104:30).

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

Today, the languages of the whole world arise to God in a Pentecost of praise. In some American dioceses, the Mass is offered every Sunday in more than thirty different languages, including the silent praise of American Sign Language. Fifty years ago, the landscape of liturgy was very different. It was grounded firmly in Latin, which is to the present day still the official language of the Roman Rite. Very few people were fluent in Latin, even though in those days Latin was far more widely studied in school. Nevertheless, almost every Catholic was competent in the responses and chants of Latin since it is not difficult to pronounce. The clergy were normally minimally competent in Latin, since much of seminary education was conducted in that language.

When the Second Vatican Council was convened, all of the debate and daily work of the council was to be in Latin. In the first session in 1962, Boston's Cardinal Richard Cushing continually complained about it, and threatened not to return in 1963 if something wasn't done. He convinced the fathers when he rose to speak in fairly fluent Latin in an unforgettable Boston twang. The next year, he returned, but with a simultaneous translation system funded by the people of Boston. The ordinary everyday language of the people, the vernacular, had arrived at the Vatican via Boston!

**"Myths of Annulments"**

Myth #1:

"An annulment will make my children illegitimate."

TRUTH: An annulment has no civil effect and does not change the status or "legitimacy" of children.

Myth # 2

"It's just a "Catholic divorce."

TRUTH: The purpose of a civil divorce is to declare the end of a marriage. The purpose of an annulment is to determine the truth regarding the validity of a marriage at the time of the exchange of consent and thereby determine the status of the parties in the Catholic Church.

Myth #3"

Marriages held outside a Catholic Church don't count, therefore, no annulment is needed.

TRUTH: The Catholic Church presumes all marriages between a man and a woman are valid until proven otherwise. This includes marriages of Catholics, unbaptized persons, non-Christians and atheists and includes marriages held at a church, winery, wedding chapel, backyard, beach, etc.

### ENVÍA TU ESPIRITU

La semana pasada oímos que después de la Ascensión, los discípulos, María y otros seguidores del Señor se retiraron al piso alto donde perseveraron unánimes en la oración. Esta semana escuchamos que, mientras estaban en oración allí, el Espíritu Santo vino sobre ellos. La promesa de Jesús, luego de su Resurrección que el Evangelio de hoy relata, se cumple: el poder del Espíritu Santo viene sobre los seguidores de Jesús. ### TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El día 9 de junio del año 1597, falleció el jesuita José de Anchieta proveniente de las Islas Canarias, España. Este santo “apóstol de Brasil” fue beatificado en 1980 gracias a sus grandes esfuerzos humanitarios, literarios y evangelizadores en Brasil. Llegó a Brasil en 1553 donde aprendió Tupí, el idioma de los nativos. Enseñaba a los indígenas, evangelizándolos con la doctrina cristiana y educándolos en historia, filosofía y medicina. Eventualmente fundó el colegio jesuita de São Paulo de Piratinga donde tuvo la audacia de educar, junto a los hijos de los nativos, los hijos de los portugueses. Para este esfuerzo escribió muchos libros y manuales, cosa que le mereció ser el primer escritor en Brasil.

Además de ser un escritor prolífico, este misionero dedicó su vida a predicar el Evangelio en Brasil, país que cruzó a pie, fundando pueblos y escuelas para los indígenas cristianos. Estos le llamaban el “santo volador” por la velocidad con que caminaba. Su celo por el Evangelio lo motivaba a seguir caminando. Como dice el profeta Isaías: “Que hermosos son los pies del que trae buena nuevas” (Isaías 52:7).

### EL ESPIRITU SANTO CAMBIA LOS APOSTOLES

Al atardecer de aquel día, el primero de la semana, estando encerrados, por miedo a los judíos, las puertas del lugar donde se encontraban los discípulos, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos y les dijo: «La paz con vosotros». Dicho esto, les mostró las manos y el costado. Los discípulos se alegraron de ver al Señor. Jesús les dijo otra vez: «La paz con vosotros. Como el Padre me envió, también yo os envío». Dicho esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: «Recibid el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados; a quienes se los retengáis, les quedan retenidos».

Oración introductoria:

Ven, Espíritu Santo, llena mi corazón y enciende el fuego de tu amor. Envía tu Espíritu Creador y renueva la faz de la tierra. Oh Dios, que has iluminado los corazones de tus hijos con la luz del Espíritu Santo; hazme dócil a tus inspiraciones para gustar siempre el bien y gozar de su consuelo. Por Cristo nuestro Señor.

Petición:

Espíritu Santo, mira mi vacío si Tú faltas, por eso te suplico vengas hacer en mi tu morada.

Reflexión:

Para cuántos de nosotros el Espíritu Santo es precisamente eso: ¡una paloma! De esa forma descendió sobre Cristo el día de su bautismo en el Jordán y así se le ha representado muchas veces en el arte sagrado. Pero ¡el Espíritu Santo no es una paloma! ¿Cómo se puede tener un trato humano, profundo y personal con un animalito irracional? La paloma es, a lo mucho, un bello símbolo de la paz, y nada más. Y, sin embargo, el Espíritu Santo es la tercera Persona de la Trinidad Santísima y Dios verdadero. Que nos inspira amar profundamente a Dios y a los demás.
