

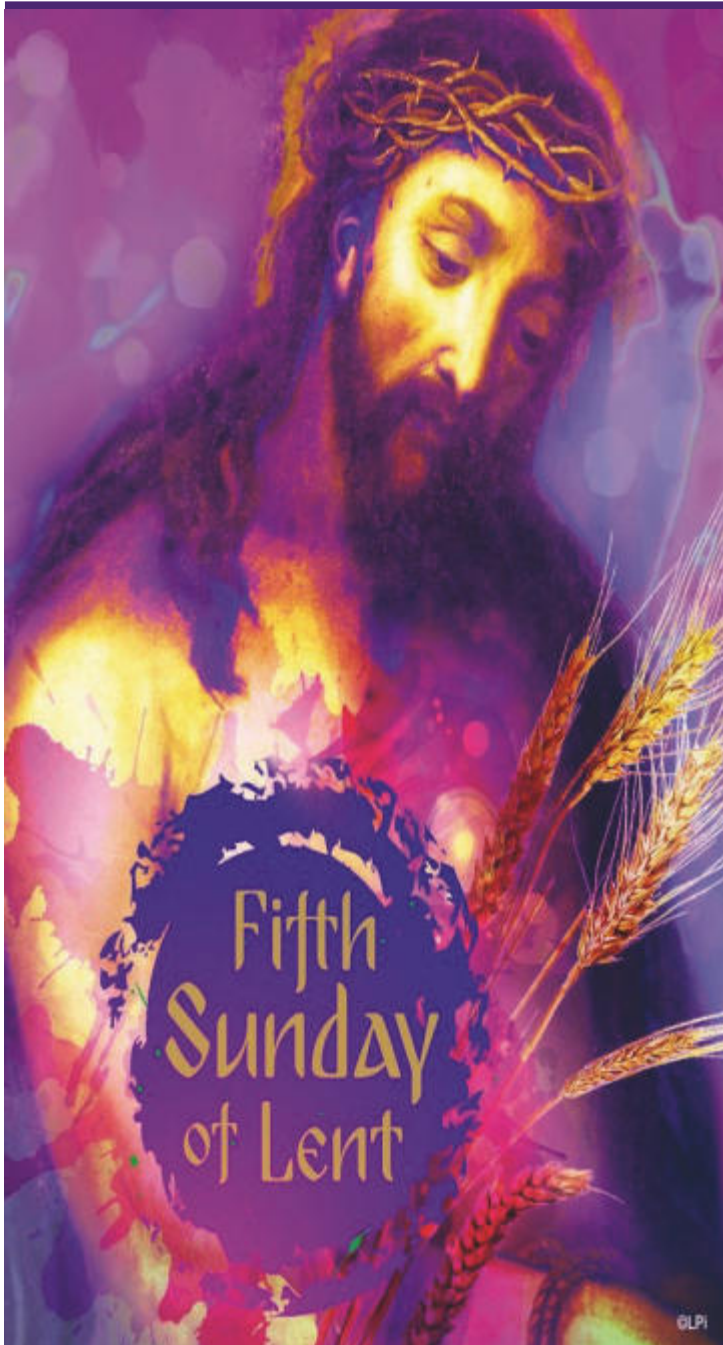

## In accordance with the Mass and Ministry COVID-19 Guideline Updates, Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, February 22, 2021

As we move into the second year of the COVID pandemic with vaccinations underway, the guidelines for Mass, receptions and parish gatherings will begin to transition back to a more normal situation. Below are updated guidelines **effective March 1**.

The new and updated guidelines are in bold. Archbishop Coakley asks us to follow the guidelines to ensure the safety of parishioners and guests while maintaining a welcoming environment. City, state and federal ordinances should be followed.

### Guiding Principles

**In accordance with the Guideline update from the Archdiocese, we encourage parishioners to return to Mass, especially with broadening vaccination efforts,**

Charity: Out of concern for our vulnerable brothers and sisters, [CDC guidelines](https://www.cdc.gov/guidelines), including mask wearing and social distancing ought to be the norm.

### In the Mass

Cloth face coverings must be worn by congregants age 6 and older and servers except when receiving communion;

Cloth face coverings must be worn by those distributing communion;

**Attendance at Mass can be increased to 50% or more capacity as long as social distancing between households is maintained in the pews;**

The dispensation for Sunday Mass remains in place;

**Hymnals can be returned to the pews;**

## Communion

**Distribution of communion will be returned to the traditional placement during Mass; Receiving in the hand is encouraged. Parishioners are encouraged to sanitize their hands before receiving communion.**

## In-Person Faith Formation and Other Ministries

Cloth face coverings must be worn by all participants age 6 and older except for:

Outdoor programs that involve separation of households or families;

The activity (e.g., eating or sports) makes mask wearing impossible.

Social distancing should be observed;

COVID-19 waivers must be obtained by all participants of in-person faith formation and other par-

## Receptions and Social Gatherings

**Large parish-wide social gatherings are permitted as space and social distancing allow. Outdoor spaces are encouraged;**

**Receptions with dancing are still prohibited;**

**Guests should be encouraged to eat and drink at tables;**

Smaller social gatherings/receptions/meetings may be held with pastor approval where:

**Attendance allows for social distancing of individuals or by household given the size of the room or gathering space;**

**Food service/distribution – should provide individual servings or have staff/catering employee/volunteer serve; please do not distribute self-serve buffet style or in common buckets/bowls/platters;**

Cloth face coverings are worn by all participants age 6 and older;

Social distancing is always observed;

City, state and federal ordinances and mandates should be followed.

**Abuse of Minors and Vulnerable Adults**  
**Archdiocese of OKC Bulletin Announcement**

The Archdiocese of Oklahoma City through its programs, organizations and events, has numerous daily contacts with many minors and vulnerable adults. It is, therefore, important that all Archdiocesan Personnel, clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers, protect the rights of children and vulnerable adults and be alert to the possibility for child abuse and abuse of vulnerable adults. Under Oklahoma State law, all individuals MUST report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18 years of age) to the civil authorities immediately. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services has established a statewide abuse hotline for reporting: 1-800-522-3511. This number is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If you have reason to believe a child is in immediate danger of harm call 911. For the safety of children and vulnerable adults and the healing of victims, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City provides an Abuse of Minors and Vulnerable Adults Pastoral Response Hotline for reporting the abuse of minors and vulnerable adults (in the past or presently) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel: 1-405-720-9878. The Archdiocesan Victims Assistance Coordinator, a licensed professional counselor, will respond to calls to the Archdiocesan Pastoral Response Hotline. A report to the Archdiocese does not relieve the individual of the duty to report child abuse to civil authorities as required by Oklahoma State Law. In Oklahoma, failure to report child abuse is a misdemeanor punishable by law.
