Dear Saint Basil Families-

Thank you all for a successful first quarter together. It is the partnership between Saint Basil and our families that has kept us safe since our first day on August 31. As we look ahead to the second quarter, with two holidays coming and other opportunities to travel and meet with family and friends, we ask everyone to make the safety of our staff, students and families a priority.

The Saint Basil COVID-19 2020-2021 School Year Plan has been amended to the following:

Employees and students who have traveled within the US must evaluate precautions used during travel, and experiences during travel, to assess the need to stay home and monitor for symptoms for 14 days upon return from travel. If, during your travels, you came in direct contact with a person who had tested positive with the COVID-19 virus, we ask that you self-quarantine for the recommended (14) days, starting from date of last exposure. **Amended 10-28-2020**

The following will remain the same concerning any international travel:

Family/parent/student/employee international travel: If traveling internationally, you must self-quarantine for 14 days before returning to school.

If you are around others who have traveled internationally, we ask that you please take precautions and monitor yourself for symptoms for 14 days.
