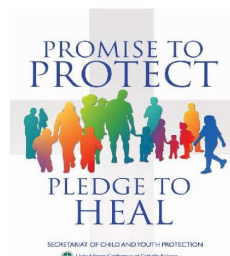

St. John Neumann

Fiesta Patronal: 5 de enero

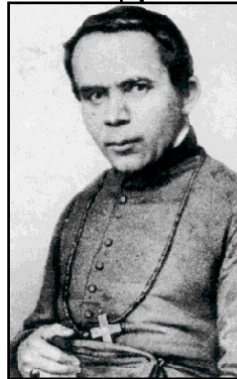
This American saint was born in Bohemia in 1811. In 1835 the bishop decided there would be no more ordinations; Bohemia was overstocked with priests. John wrote to bishops all over Europe but no one wanted any more priests. John was sure he was called to be a priest and didn't give up. He wrote to the bishops in America. No one would accept him there either. In order to follow God's call to the priesthood John would have to leave his home forever and travel across the ocean. John arrived to America with one tattered suit of clothes and \$1.00 in his pocket.

After his arrival, John discovered the Bishop of New York had agreed to ordain him; and so John was ordained into the priest hood on June 25, 1836. John spent most of his time traveling from village to village, climbing mountains to visit the sick, staying in garrets and taverns to teach, and celebrating the Mass at kitchen tables.

Because of the work and the isolation of his parish, John longed for community and so joined the Redemptorists, a congregation of priests and brothers dedicated to helping the poor and most abandoned.

John was appointed bishop of Philadelphia in 1852. As bishop, he was the first to organize a diocesan Catholic school system. A founder of Catholic education in this country, he increased the number of Catholic schools in his diocese from two to 100.

John died on **January 5**, 1860 at the age of 48.



Este santo Americano nació en Bohemia en 1811. En 1835 el obispo declare que no habrían mas ordenaciones ya que Bohemia tenia demasiados sacerdotes. Juan le escribió a obispos de todos los países en Europa; pero ninguno quería mas sacerdotes. Juan sabia que era su llamado ser un sacerdote y no se dio por vencido. Le escribió también a los obispos en América; pero ahí tampoco lo querían.

Para seguir su llamado al sacerdocio Juan tendría que dejar su hogar y viajar a través del océano. Juan llegó a América con un traje andrajoso y \$1.00 en su bolsillo.

Después de su llegada, Juan descubrió que el Obispo de Nueva York estaba dispuesto a ordenarlo.

El 25 de junio de 1836 Juan fue ordenado al sacerdocio.

Juan pasaba la mayoría de su tiempo viajando de pueblo a pueblo, subiendo montañas para visitar a los enfermos, durmiendo en buhardillas y tabernas para enseñar, y celebrando la misa en cocinas. Por el trabajo y el aislamiento de su parroquia, Juan anhelaba una comunidad, así que se unió a los

Redentoristas, una congregación de sacerdotes y hermanos religiosos dedicados a la ayuda a los mas pobres y abandonados. Juan fue nombrado obispo de Filadelfia en 1852. Como obispo, fue el primero en organizar un sistema de escuelas católicas diocesanas. Como fundador de la educación católica en este país, el incremento el numero de escuelas católicas en su diócesis de ser 2 a 100.

Juan falleció el **5 de enero** 1860 a la edad de 48.
