

## The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

November 21/22

**All:** In the name of the + Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit  
(While standing, all make the Sign of the Cross)

**Leader:** Let us call to mind our sins... (pause to think on your sins)  
You were sent to heal the contrite of heart; Lord have mercy

**All:** Lord have mercy

**Leader:** You came to call all sinners; Christ have mercy

**All:** Christ have mercy

**Leader:** You are seated at the right hand of the Father to intercede for us; Lord have mercy

**All:** Lord have mercy

## GLORIA

Glory to God in the highest  
and on earth peace to people of good will.

We praise you,  
we bless you,  
we adore you,  
we glorify you,  
we give you thanks for your great glory,  
Lord God, heavenly King,  
O God, almighty Father.

Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,  
Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,  
you take away the sins of the world,

Leader:            **A Reading from the first Book of the Prophet Ezekial**

Thus says the Lord GOD:  
I myself will look after and tend my sheep.  
As a shepherd tends his flock  
when he finds himself among his scattered sheep,  
so will I tend my sheep.  
I will rescue them from every place where they were  
scattered  
when it was cloudy and dark.  
I myself will pasture my sheep;  
I myself will give them rest, says the Lord GOD.  
The lost I will seek out,  
the strayed I will bring back,  
the injured I will bind up,

the sick I will heal,  
but the sleek and the strong I will destroy,  
shepherding them rightly.

**R. The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.**


Only goodness and kindness follow me

**Reader: A Reading from the first Letter of Paul to the Corinthians**

Brothers and sisters:  
Christ has been raised from the dead,  
the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.  
For since death came through man,  
the resurrection of the dead came also through man.  
For just as in Adam all die,  
so too in Christ shall all be brought to life,  
but each one in proper order:  
Christ the firstfruits;  
then, at his coming, those who belong to Christ;  
then comes the end,  
when he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father,

when he has destroyed every sovereignty  
and every authority and power.  
For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under  
his feet.  
The last enemy to be destroyed is death.  
When everything is subjected to him,  
then the Son himself will also be subjected  
to the one who subjected everything to him,  
so that God may be all in all.

**(Please Stand)**

**Leader: A Reading from the Holy Gospel According to Matthew**

Jesus said to his disciples:  
"When the Son of Man comes in his glory,  
and all the angels with him, he will sit upon his glorious  
throne,  
and all the nations will be assembled before him.  
And he will separate them one from another, as a  
shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.  
He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his  
left.  
Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you  
who are blessed by my Father.  
Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the  
foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave  
me food,  
I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you  
welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you  
cared for me, in prison and you visited me.'

Then the righteous will answer him and say,  
'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you,  
or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a  
stranger and welcome you,  
or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in  
prison, and visit you?'  
And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to  
you, whatever you did  
for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.'

Then he will say to those on his left,  
'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire  
prepared for the devil and his angels.  
For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty  
and you gave me no drink,  
a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you  
gave me no clothing,  
ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.' Then they  
will answer and say,  
'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a  
stranger or naked or ill or in prison,  
and not minister to your needs?' He will answer them,  
'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of  
these least ones, you did not do for me.'

And these will go off to eternal punishment,  
but the righteous to eternal life." **(A brief pause is  
observed)**

## Profession of Faith

I believe in God,

For all those who are sick, those who support the sick, and all those affected by the COVID-19 Virus. We especially call to mind those in our community struggling with the virus.

For our dead, and all those who have died, that through the hope of Resurrection, they may find peace at last in heaven.

We Pray to the Lord **℟ . Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: **Heavenly Father, you crowned your Son as King of the Universe for our own benefit. Help us to defer all judgments and concerns to His throne, that our observance of His will may permit Him to reign in our Hearts. We ask for this grace to be Given in the Holy Spirit, Amen.**

Leader: With longing for God’s Kingdom, let us pray the words Jesus taught us:

All: **Our Father** who art...

Leader: **Let us Pray**  
(Pause for a brief moment of silence to collect ourselves)

Having received the food of immortality,  
we ask, O Lord,  
that, glorying in obedience  
to the commands of Christ, the King of the Universe,  
we may live with him eternally in his heavenly Kingdom.

Through Christ our Lord. Amen

All: May the Lord Bless us + protect us from evil, and bring us to everlasting life.  
(Parents can bless their children as they did during the Baptism Ritual, by making the sign of the cross on their children’s forehead) & (Make the sign of the cross)
