## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Elementary Catechesis and 1<sup>st</sup> Communion

A Message from Ms. Lisa:

“Hello 2nd grade Catechesis class welcome back to week 2. Our 1st lesson plan will begin with understanding that YOU ARE BLESSED! A simple way to remember this is knowing you are a Child of God, Blessed because you are His precious creation.

### **Main Lesson:**

1. Please invite mom & dad to join us in our **opening prayer**:
  - a. “God, our loving Father, thank you for all the ways you Bless me. Help me to be aware that every person, place & adventure I experience is an opportunity to love you more. Fill me with a desire to change, grow & give me the grace to become the best version of myself in every moment of every day. Amen”
  - b. Opening Prayer can also be found on P. 1 in the “Blessed: First Reconciliation” Book.
2. Visit <https://dynamiccatholic.com/blessed/program-view/first-reconciliation/session-1> and scroll to the bottom to watch the first two videos, “Welcome,” and “You are Blessed,” from Session 1.
  - a. **“Welcome Video”**
    - i. Read pages 2-3 after watching this video.
    - ii. What are you most excited about this year in receiving your 1<sup>st</sup> Communion?
  - b. **“You are Blessed”**
    - i. Read pages 4-5 after watching this video.
    - ii. Answer and discuss this question: What does it mean to be blessed?
    - iii. Answer and discuss this question: What is the greatest gift you have ever received? Why?
3. Additional coloring Activity (attached to the e-mail and website)
  - a. **“Say Yes to God”** Activity
