MASS INTENTIONS POLICY

In order to allow ALL Parishioners an opportunity to schedule Masses, we are implementing the following procedure: Mass requests for the next calendar year will be accepted beginning November 1st. MASS INTENTIONS THAT HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED WILL BE SCHEDULED BEGINNING DECEMBER 1ST. Parishioners may request more than one date/time during the year, but the following will apply:

1. Requests will be randomly sorted.
2. Up to three dates/times requested by the first person will be entered on the schedule. The request page will go to the back of the requests.
3. Up to three dates/times requested by the second person will be entered on the schedule. The request page will go to the back of the requests.
4. This will continue with all requests until all masses have been scheduled. If your requested dates are not available, alternate dates/times will be allotted as near as possible to the dates requested.

*Please include your email or mailing address with your request so that your schedule may be sent to you.

HEARING IMPAIRED?

We have installed a FM-Radio transmitter in the church which is active for all church events. Small digital FM pocket radios with ear buds can be purchased on-line at Wal-Mart, Amazon, etc. for \$12.00 and up.
