In these times of aloneness, we feel the support of our parish family in spirit through their prayers. Although many of us cannot attend Mass in person, we are aware of the love of our family in Christ.

Pope Benedict comments on this in one of his meditations: "Part of the essence of Christianity..... is that our relationship to God is not just an inner one, one made up of my 'I' and his 'Thou', but is also a matter of being spoken to, of being led. A meeting is a path to every conversion. The Church is there so that people who have searched for the door and found it can be in her. Among all the variety of temperaments, there will always be someone who suits me and has the right word to say to me. As human beings we are there so that God can come to people by way of other people.... So we, too, always come to him through other people who are being led by him, in whom he himself meets us and opens us up to him. If we could lift ourselves up to the ultimate degree simply by reading Holy Scripture, then this would be just another philosophical movement, without this element of community that is such a vital element in faith."
