Last Friday, we celebrated the feast day of St. Thomas, one of the 12 apostles. When we speak of him, our immediate thought is "doubting Thomas". The disciple who refused to believe that they had seen Christ until "I see the mark of the nails in his hands...and put my hand into his side". *John 20:25*. But we first hear of Thomas in *John 11:5-16* when Jesus wanted to return to Judea and the apostles warned him of the animosity of the Jews. To which Thomas replied, "Let us also go to die with him." *John 11:16*.

Again at the last supper, we hear from Thomas as he does not understand when Jesus says, "I will come again and take you to myself so that where I am you will also be." Then Thomas says to him, "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" To which Jesus replies, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me." *John 14:3-6*
