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### Vision and Hearing Screenings Week of September 9th

The school nurse will be conducting vision and hearing screenings during the week of September 9<sup>th</sup>. The State of Texas requires that we screen students in Pre-K, K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> grades as well as all new students to the school. <u>If your child wears glasses or contacts please make sure they wear them for the testing. They need to be tested with their glasses or contacts.</u> Parents will only be notified of the results if their student fails any of the screenings.

The nurse will also be testing for <u>Acanthosis Nigricans</u>, which is a black-brown velvety marker that usually appears on the back of the neck. It is the result of too much insulin in the blood. It is a prediabetic condition and serves as an indicator of risk for Type 2 Diabetes and other chronic health problems. Acanthosis Nigricans is usually seen during the pre-adolescent and adolescent years. Early detection and an intervention of diet changes and physical activity are important. This testing involves the students in 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup>grades. The screening is done by checking the back of the student's neck and looking for the appearance of a dark line, or raised thickened skin.
