



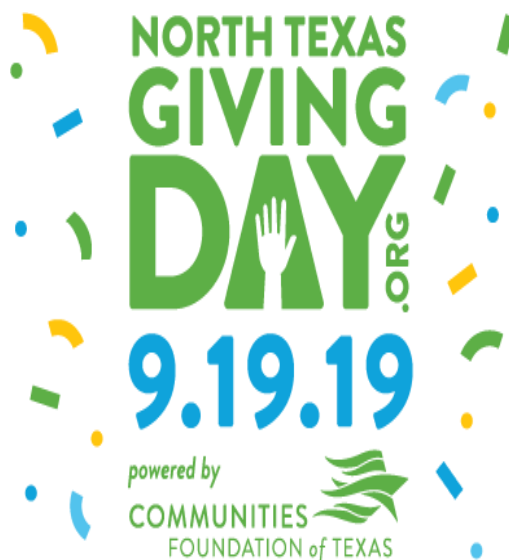

- Your student can wear a green t-shirt with their uniform,
