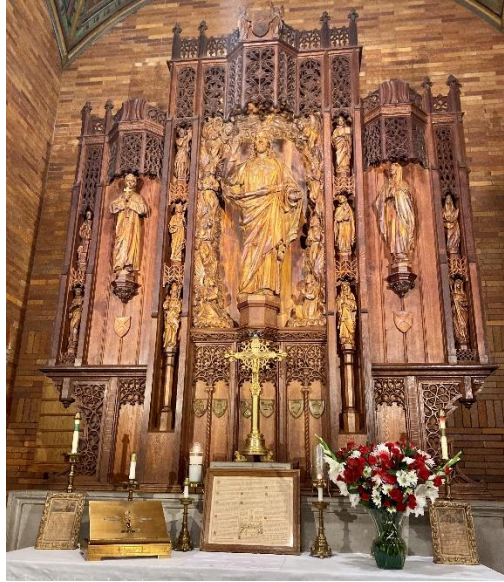

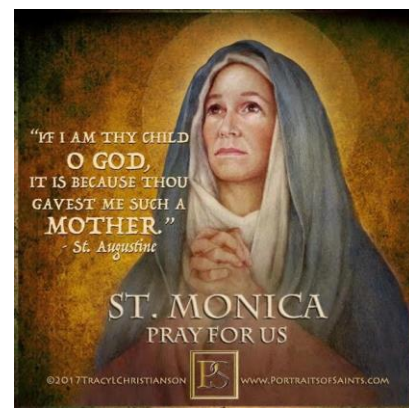

The shorter days and cooler nights of late August carry with them the anticipation of a new school year. Although we will miss the unstructured days of summer, we are often excited for a return to routine and the opportunities to learn and grow that each new school year provides. We at St. Marys of the Assumption Parish and Shrine are also anticipating new learning opportunities for the youth of our community. Faith formation is an integral part of our lifelong journey as Catholics to know, love, and serve God. To that end, we are pleased to offer sacramental prep as well as classes for all youth beginning with pre-K. Materials for our classes have been chosen based on their traditional and orthodox approach to Catholicism. Through meaningful catechesis, we hope to encourage a lifelong love of our faith and a pious adherence to Catholic doctrine.

As St. Mary's newly appointed Director of Religious Education, I am pleased to be a part of your child's faith journey. I am a high school English teacher currently employed in the Mexico School District, where I have been teaching since 2008. I have a bachelors degree from SUNY Brockport and a Masters degree from Syracuse University. As much as I enjoy teaching English, personally preparing students for the sacrament of Confirmation will be even more rewarding and I am honored to have been entrusted with this tremendously important role.

I look forward to meeting you and your children over the next few weeks as we begin the enrollment process. Bi-weekly classes will be held on Sunday mornings between the 9:00 a.m. Traditional Latin Mass, and the 12:00 English Mass, with additional home study assigned in between class dates. (When registering, choose "envelopes.")

Please include the word "donation" and your parishioner number, if known, in the memo or note section.
- 4) Anonymous cash donations or loose checks can be put into the collection basket; however, despite our volunteers' best efforts, loose checks may not be properly matched to parishioner accounts or recorded for year-end statements. If you have questions or need assistance, please contact the parish office.
