To avoid unnecessary buying of materials, please follow these guidelines.

Each child must have:

Assignment pad to be purchased in school in Sept. (Cost \$3.50)

8 marble composition notebooks

8 folders

2 packs loose-leaf paper

1 pack (100 count) 3x5 index cards

Headphones

6 book socks

Art smock

Pencil case with ten sharpened pencils with erasers, erasable pens, red pen, pencil sharpener, a big eraser, ruler (metric and inches)

Glue sticks, scissors, wet glue, crayons, markers, colored pencils, 1 sharpie, 2 highlighters, 2 dry erase markers, 1 dry erase eraser, white-out tape (No liquid white-out) and clear tape. Please place all the above items in zip-lock bags, labeled with your child's name.

Small stapler

3 boxes tissues, 3 containers Clorox wipes

Contract paper to cover paperback books (keep at home)

Scholastic News subscription to be purchased in school in September (Cost \$6.75)

Plastic box to hold everything
