2 red pens

number 2 pencils with erasers

small pencil case

12 inch ruler (standard and metric)

compass and protractor

pack of 3x5 index cards

colored pencils

highlighters (2 different colors)

scissors

clear tape

2 boxes of tissues

2 containers of disinfecting wipes (example - Clorox or Lysol)

2 containers of hand sanitizer (example - Purel)
