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**Critical Analysis/Rigor for 2nd-5<sup>th</sup> grade Reading/Language Arts**

Our students will be using Literary Elements about the passage they read- please remember it is different Genres that our students are exposed to -news articles-poems-paired passages- informational text. Example questions could be- Which words help the reader understand the meaning of “regressing”? With which statement would the author most likely agree? Why does Lisa start drawing in her binder when Mrs. Adams says that she has news for the class? What is the summary of this story?

**Please note:** some items that test **multiple-meaning words** might require students to identify the correct answer from a sample dictionary entry, with the word, part of speech and it’s different numbered meanings.
