Hybrid Attendance Model

- ▶ Hybrid Attendance Model
 - ▶ Half the students are in the Gold Stable Group
 - ▶ Half the students are in the Blue Stable Group
 - ▶ The Gold Stable Group attends in-person instruction in the morning and distance learning of auxiliary classes in the afternoon
 - ▶ The Blue Stable group has distance learning in the mornings and in-person instruction in the afternoon
- ▶ We respect that not all parents may feel comfortable with in-person instruction. We will continue to offer 100% distance learning. Students can rejoin us on campus at anytime.
- ▶ Times for School
 - ▶ Morning sessions will be from 7:45 to 11:00 am. Drop off will be from 7:30 to 7:45.
 - ▶ Afternoon sessions will be 12:15 to 3:30 pm. Drop off will be from 12:00 to 12:15.
- ▶ Rigorous disinfecting between 11:00 and 12:00.

Adaptive Classroom

- ▶ All students will wear a mask.
- ▶ Students will stay with their assigned stable group (Gold or Blue)
- ▶ Each student will have their own desk with their own supplies.
- ▶ Desks will be color coded Gold or Blue.
- ▶ All gold desks will be checkerboard style / All blue desks will be checkboard style
- ▶ All gold desks will be socially distanced / All blue desks will be socially distanced
- ▶ Each desk will have a plastic shield.
- ▶ If supplies are shared they will be disinfected after each use and students will be required to sanitize their hand.

Adaptive Outdoor Spaces

- ▶ Recess times will be staggered and play areas zoned by stable group.
- ▶ Snacks must be in disposable bags and containers.
- ▶ No sharing of food allowed.
- ▶ Leftover food will be discarded.

Visitors and Volunteers

- ▶ Visitors will check in at the table outside the parish office or outside the school office
- ▶ Visitors must wear a mask
- ▶ Volunteers with the exception of those helping to disinfect, will be limited to outside activities only
- ▶ If a student is picked up early, the parent will call the office from their car when they arrive on the parking lot, the student will meet their parent at the table outside the school office to sign them out.

Screening before School

- Before exiting the car, parents need to complete a wellness survey and students will have their temperature checked.
- ▶ Students are to stay home if they have any of the following symptoms:
 - ▶ Fever of 100.4
 - ▶ Sore throat
 - ▶ Cough
 - ▶ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - ▶ Chills
 - ▶ Muscle Aches
 - ▶ New onset of severe headache
 - ▶ Congestion
 - ▶ Runny nose
 - ▶ Diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain
 - ▶ New loss of taste or smell
 - ▶ New Excessive fatigue
- Students are to stay home
 - If exposed to a person infected with COVID-19
 - Student or anyone in student's household tested positive for COVID-19
 - If traveled internationally in past 14 days

Student Arrival and Dismissal Protocols

- ▶ Gold students arrive to school between 7:30 and 7:45 am, and Blue students arrive between 12:00 and 12:15 pm.
- ▶ Parents will drive on campus using the West Gate.
- ▶ Stop within the designated drop off zone.
- ▶ Parents cannot leave their cars.
- ▶ Students will get their temperature checked and parents answer screening questions before exiting the car.
- ▶ Students in the upper building will exit the drivers side of the car.
- ▶ Students in the lower building will exit the passenger side of the car.
- ▶ Parents drive out the East Gate.
- ▶ Gold students dismiss at 11:00 am and Blue students dismiss at 3:30 pm
- ▶ Dismissal is the same procedure, except students will be called over a loud speaker to their car.

Students should bring to school

- ▶ Two masks every day
- ▶ A filled water bottle
- ▶ Disposable snack

Safety Precautions

- ▶ Location of hand sanitizing stations
 - ▶ At each school entrance
 - ▶ Before entering the restrooms
 - ▶ In each classroom
- ▶ Two student per stable group restroom policy
- ▶ Classroom Ventilation
 - ▶ MERV 13 rated filters
 - ▶ Doors and windows open
 - ▶ Medify Air Purifiers
- ▶ Disinfecting Schedule is on our website

Independent Self-Management Skills

- ▶ Parents practice with your students:
 - ▶ Proper handwashing
 - ▶ Proper disposal of tissues
 - ▶ Proper placement and removal of masks
 - ▶ Proper way to cover mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing with elbow
 - ▶ Tying shoes
 - ▶ Avoid touching face, keeping fingers out of their mouth, nose and eyes

School Exposure

- ▶ Should a student show symptoms while on campus, we will isolate them and request immediate pickup.
- ▶ If a student tests positive there will be immediate quarantine of exposed staff and students.
- ▶ A cluster of cases will be reported to the DPH, and we will follow the instructions from the DPH.

Before School Resumes on March 2

- ▶ You are going to receive by email “COVID-19 FAMILY HEALTH COMMITMENT 2020-2021” document that will need to be printed, signed, and returned.
- ▶ Review the detailed plan for reopening on our school website.
- ▶ Review your new schedule of class times for auxiliary classes.
 - ▶ Morning classes start at 8:00, 9:00 and 10:00 am
 - ▶ Afternoon classes start at 12:15, 1:15 and 2:15 pm
- ▶ On the first day of school you will receive a sign with your student’s last name to clearly display in your car windshield at pickup time

Everyday before School

- ▶ Every morning before coming to school
 - ▶ take your student's temperature
 - ▶ review screening questions
 - ▶ thoroughly wash hands
 - ▶ Verify that your student has two masks, a water bottle and disposable snack
- ▶ Whenever needed, email teachers to arrange office hours
