**HAVE FUN WHILE HELPING OTHERS:** Are you interested in having some fun, but worried about doing it in a safe environment? **Then Feed Just One** is holding small family & close friends packing events in their warehouse just a couple blocks from St. Joseph's Church. TFJO personnel are always masked for your safety. They will train you how to pack food for the people in Honduras, who are in desperate need of food.

Each group decides if they'd like to pack a single box of food for \$34.56 that contains 216 meals, or if they'd like to pack more. Each meal is \$.16 cents, and one package feeds 6 children for \$.96! We also accept donations of any amount for those who would like to package food but are unable to do so. To date, we have held 13 of these small packing events, ranging from 1 person to a family group of 23. We have boxes for young family members to stand on and chairs for those who prefer to sit while packing. Packers have ranged in age from 3 to those who are young at heart.
