MASS STIPENDS: The tradition of asking the priest to offer Mass for a particular intention dates back at least to the Middle Ages, and reflects our belief both in *the value of intercessory prayer* and that *the Mass is our most powerful prayer*. The stipend customarily given with the request (normally \$10.00 according to diocesan policy) is a "mini Sunday collection," meant to cover the cost of bread/wine/candles and any other items used at Mass, as well an expression of appreciation to the priest. Often, the intention is for someone who has died, but Masses can be offered for virtually any personal, social, church or civic need (e.g., recovery of health; for our oppressors; for rain; for vocations to Holy Orders, for the grace of a happy death, etc.)

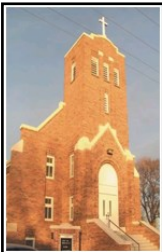
