AS HAS BEEN MENTIONED PREVIOUSLY, we have considered moving to **one Saturday evening Mass** during the summer months (June – August) as Mass crowds decrease due to summer vacation and travel. **THIS IS THE YEAR: BEGINNING THE WEEK OF JUNE 12/13, SATURDAY EVENING MASS WILL BE AT 4:30PM AT THE ST. JOSEPH BUILDING.**

THE 8:45AM DAILY MASS AT ST. JOSEPH will return to the daily Mass / adoration chapel next week beginning Tuesday, June 1.

MUSIC AND HYMNALS: With the prohibition of printed resources, we did not order the customary Breaking Bread Hymnals, not knowing whether we would be able to use them, and to avoid the unnecessary expense. Therefore, each weekend until Advent, we will offer a printed worship aid with the music for Mass that can be picked up at the door of the Church, and left at the end of the pew as you leave.

HELP YOUR PARISH!: Do you attend Mass weekly? Do you usually attend the same Mass? Please consider signing up for our Hospitality / Usher ministry! Available for men, women, responsible children, and especially for families even with smaller children – who love to help!! Needed: 4 at St. Joseph, 2 at St. James. What do you need to do?

- Be there 15 minutes early to greet people and hand out worship aids (and prove that Catholics aren't unfriendly, as we are often accused!)
 - Take up the collection
 - Bring up the collection and gifts (if there are no assigned gift bearers)
 - Distribute bulletins as people leave
 - Put the Sunday collection in bags and return baskets to the usher's room
 - Pick up worship aids from the ends of the pews and return them to the church entrance for use at the next Mass.
- Rocket Science? Not at all. It just takes people willing to get involved and serve. And if enough individuals / families volunteer, it would not be every week!!!! Training would be given.

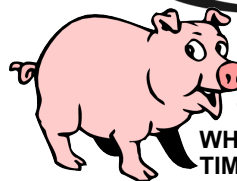
