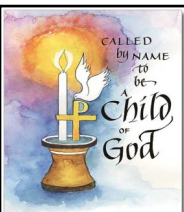
THE ALL SAINTS PARISH ENDOWMENT FUND made its annual distribution to the parish operating budget at the beginning of the month in the amount of \$80,960. Since 2015 when the separate St. James and St. Joseph Endowments were merged, the amount contributed is \$1,784,956. At present, the Endowment is valued at \$10,219,430 in farmland and investments. We are grateful to all who contribute to the Endowment, which helps take the pressure off our weekly giving.
