This morning Queen of Angels Catholic School became notified about a staff member that had tested positive for COVID-19. Due to this exposure we have been working on contact tracing to make sure that any and all parties that may be affected, have been contacted.

I have reached out to all families whose students may have been impacted and have made those that I was able to reach, aware of the situation. Due to this exposure and the number impacted, I have decided that school will be closed on both Monday, November 23rd and Tuesday, November 24th. During this time we will ensure that all areas are cleaned and sanitized again. Also, during this time, teachers will come in and prepare lessons to be able to teach through virtual/distance learning the week of November 30th - December 4th. As long as the Allen County Health Department gives us permission, we will begin in-person learning on Monday, December 7, 2020.

I know that students may not have the materials or equipment at home to be able to complete the work that week, so we will set up times on Monday afternoon and Tuesday, throughout the day, for families to pick up their devices and/or materials needed for virtual/distance learning.

The two days that we will need to take off to prepare, will be made up on two of our Snow Make-up days for the year. We do apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause and please let us know if we can be of assistance.
