

Queen of Angels Virtual Option

Dear Parents,

As we begin to start navigating what the school year will entail this year, we do know that we will be offering a virtual option for parents who do not feel comfortable sending their child back to the classroom setting. Please find below the information on how our virtual option will be presented.

Parent Chooses the Virtual Option

If you choose to have the virtual option, then we will have a digital daily attendance form that you will need to fill out. This link will be accessed through our website and will be similar to the distance learning attendance form from last year. Teachers will record their mini-lessons that they will be teaching to the students that are in-person, and then at the end of the day, the teacher will upload the videos and send them out to the student through either Google Classroom or SeeSaw. Students will watch the videos and then will email the teacher with any questions that they may have. (***Note:** all students will have an email address through Queen of Angels)

Completing work will be very important as your attendance will also be determined by completed work. If your child did not perform well with digital or distance learning last year, you may want to consider the in-person option. The teacher will grade the work sent digitally. However, if no work is being completed, the student will be considered absent and we will use the same absenteeism protocols set by the State, as if the student was completing in-person learning.

Students without Devices

We were fortunate to receive a grant that has provided us with twenty-five mobile Wi-fi devices for those families who do not have internet access at home. There will be an agreement form that will need to be completed in order to be eligible for one of these devices. We will also have a similar form for families who need a computer to complete student work. We have purchased Chromebooks that can be checked out for use for the school year. Both forms will inform families of the importance of having these devices at home, as well as an agreement that if anything happens to the device, parents will be responsible for repairing or replacing the device.

Signing up for Virtual Learning


In order for the teachers to be able to appropriately prepare for the school year, we are asking parents who are interested in Virtual learning for their student(s), to sign up for this option. To sign up, you will need to email us at info@queenofangelsschool.com with details including: your child(ren)'s name(s), grades, and whether you will need 1) Internet access and 2) a computer. ***The deadline for virtual learning sign-ups is Wednesday, August 12, 2020.***

In the case that you do sign-up for virtual learning, please note that this will be a nine (9) week commitment. This means that your child will have virtual learning for the first nine (9) weeks and then at the end of that time period, we will re-evaluate. The student could then be eligible to return to in-person classroom instruction. If you choose to continue virtually, then that will last another nine (9) week period.

Please know that we are working very hard to provide a safe place for in-person learning as well as for this virtual option. Please keep all of our schools and students in your prayers and remember to have grace and patience with us as we navigate through these new methods of instruction from our teachers.
