- ❖ If Tuition and fees are paid in full by August 1, 2021, you will receive a 5% discount on the tuition portion of your bill.

## Explanation of Tuition, Registration, & Financial Assistance

This year's tuition per student (K-8) is set at \$6,450.00--the total cost to educate a child. Any family who is considered an "**Active Parishioner**" will be provided a discount to your tuition (see Tuition Schedule on previous page). These discounts were figured based on the number of students attending Queen of Angels for the current school year. In order to be considered eligible as an "Active Parishioner," the following criteria should be met:

- 1) Be a registered member of Queen of Angels Catholic Church for the previous year.  
(PLEASE NOTE: Registered members must complete the [Stewardship Commitment Form](#) attached)
- 2) Commit to stewardship of time and talent to the parish and or school (10 hours during that school year).
- 3) Attend Saturday evening/Sunday Mass each weekend with your children.
- 4) Use your offertory envelopes weekly as you make a commitment of stewardship of treasure.

**Preschool Tuition:** Preschool rates are based on a 5-day week. If you choose to send your child less than 5 days (ex. M-W-F ½ day), you will still be invoiced at the "Full Day" rate. (All Preschool families will need to complete the "[Program Selection Form](#)" (attached) to share your specific request for full or half days)

**Student Insurance:** This fee is a requirement for all students.

**Registration:** This year parents will enroll their students online through *PowerSchool Enrollment*. **An email will be sent inviting the parent to create an account** and then complete the registration process.

(NOTE: This account is different from your child's PowerSchool grades account)

- The \$200 **Registration Fee** is a "**per family fee**" and can be paid by check, cash, or money order sent into the school office. (No enrollment is complete, until this fee is paid!)
  - This year, **if you pay by April 15**, your Registration fee is discounted 50% (**\$100**).
- After your online registration is completed and the fee is paid, you will receive a **2nd email explaining the criteria for receiving the Choice Scholarship and SGO Scholarship**. Instructions on how to register for **FACTS Grant and Aid will be included** (this completed application will qualify you to schedule your financial assistance appointment with our office for SGO Scholarships or Parish Aid.)

**Financial Assistance:** All school families--re-enrolling or new--will be required to register online with *FACTS Grant & Aid, before being considered for an SGO Scholarship or Parish Aid*.

\*By registering through *FACTS*, you can provide us with financial information that will be valuable to assess your situation and to see if you are eligible for financial assistance.

\*Please note: we have staff who can walk you through this process here at school if needed; and know that your application in *FACTS Grant & Aid* will be held in strict confidence.

**Financial Aid may come in three different ways** and will be based on need as well as income guidelines set by the individual scholarship organizations (thus the importance of completing *FACTS Grant and Aid*):

- 1) The **first type of aid** is the **Indiana Choice Scholarship**. There are income guidelines set by the state of Indiana, so parents will need to **provide their 2020 tax forms** to the school in order to check for eligibility. **The State will then determine the award amount for each child** and parents will then need to fill out the proper paperwork with the school.
- 2) The **second type of aid** is the **SGO (Scholarship Granting Organization)**. This aid is available to **all** Kindergarten students and other students whose families meet the financial need criteria (K-8). The school will also determine the amount of aid available based on how much scholarship money is available in the school SGO account.
- 3) The **third type of aid** is the **Tuition Assistance through the Parish**. If assistance is still needed, and parents have filled out the "**need**" portion of the **FACTS Grant & Aid** enrollment, then the parish can consider you for additional support. (**Available PK thru 8**)

\*All Financial Aid given to families is held in the strictest confidence, and we request that you do the same.
