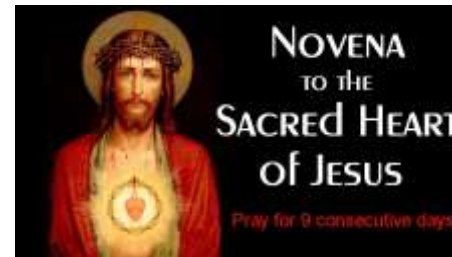

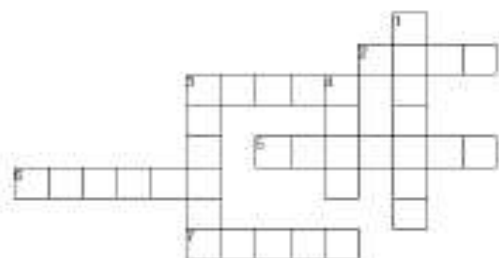


First reading

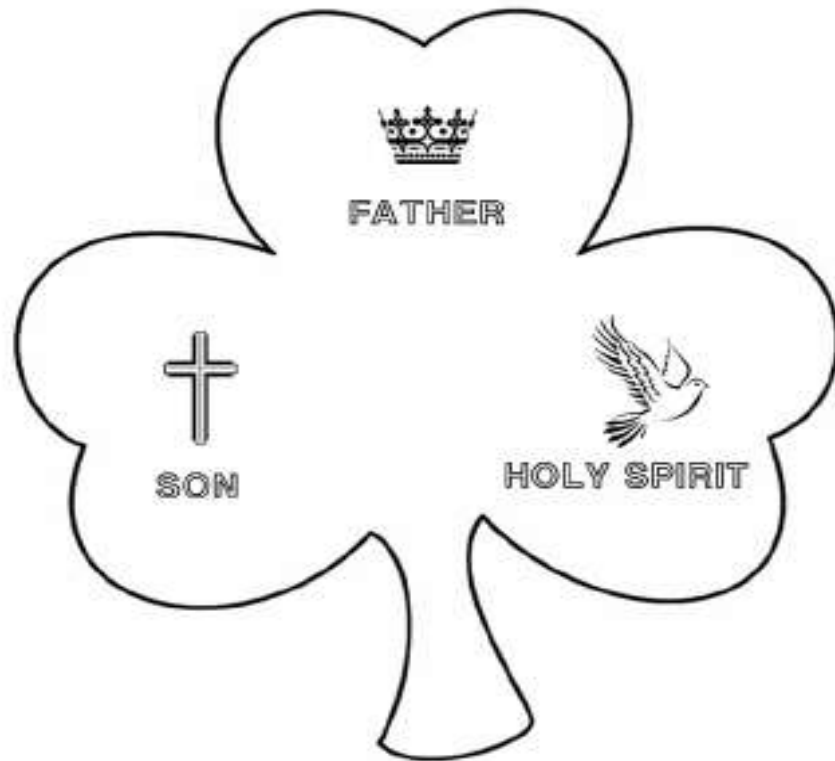
