

Re-Opening for Mass

Due to Government regulations, numbers at Mass are very limited and so entry will only be permitted to those who have successfully pre-booked a place. Volunteers will check the names as you enter the church.

We are using *Eventbrite* to manage our bookings. You will find a link to book a place at Mass at Saint Helen's [here](#) and on the parish website and FaceBook page. Please follow the instructions to request a place at one of the available Masses.

Bookings are open for the following dates and times:

Weekend of 1st/2nd August

Vigil (Sat) 5.30 pm, 9.00 and 11.00 am and 5.00 pm

Weekdays

Monday 3rd and Thursday 6th August at 10.00 am

Weekend of 8th/9th August

Vigil (Sat) 5.30 pm, 9.00 and 11.00 am and 5.00 pm

From the week beginning 1st August we will gradually begin to recommence weekday Masses (on Monday 3rd and Thursday 6th). Since there is currently a high demand on places please consider NOT booking more than one place a week. Since there is currently no obligation to attend on a Sunday, having some weekday Masses might allow someone who has not been able to get a place at least to get to a Mass one day that week.

Please continue to ensure that if you are booking for more than one person you include EACH INDIVIDUAL NAME in your booking – its fine just to duplicate the contact details if you are all in the one household.

Please also cancel your booking if you can no longer take up the place (Go into your email confirmation and scroll down to

'manage my booking' and then choose the option to Cancel. This frees up the place(s) for someone else.

If you have not been able to get a place, remember you can book up until 2 hours before a Mass, so it's worth checking back to see if any places have become available.

Please also remember the following:

- **If you are shielding or have any symptoms, please do not consider booking a place.**
- **Face Coverings must be worn at all times within the Church** (even during Mass)
- **Hands must be sanitized** with the sanitizer provided on entry and exit
- Volunteers will welcome you and direct you to a **designated** place which will ensure social distancing from other visitors
- Please follow the instructions of the volunteers at all times.
- In order to minimize the length of time people are gathered, there have been some adjustments to the Liturgy
- No congregational singing is permitted.
- Holy Communion can be received but with a different system in place – this will be explained at Mass

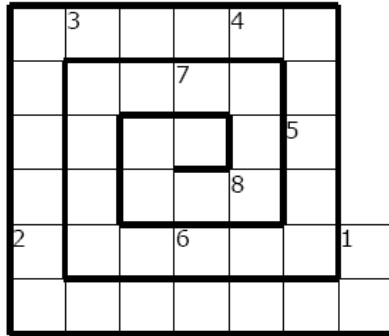
FIRST READING

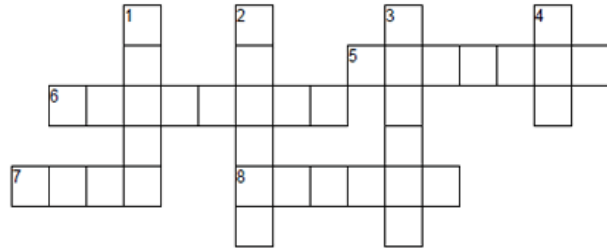
