



# HOLY WEEK

We are delighted to be back in the Church for the solemn celebrations of Holy Week. The programme is listed below, but please note the following points:

- Attendance at all the public services (with the exception of Confessions) are by **pre-booking only**. You can make a booking by visiting the [RESERVATIONS PAGE](#) on the parish website.
- If you are unable to do this (or ask someone to do it for you), you can use the booking number (**07561 646339**) on a Friday or Monday between 11.00 am and 1.00 pm
- For the Solemn Liturgy of the Passion on Good Friday at 3.00 pm and for all the Easter Sunday Masses (including the Vigil) there will also be extra places in the hall, where a live video link to the Church will be provided. Places in the hall also need to be pre-booked through the Reservations Page.
- Confessions are available in the hall at the times noted below. You are asked to follow the guidance of the stewards and observe the one-way system – entering by the usual side door and exiting through the emergency exit door.
- Demand for places over Holy Week and Easter is very high. If you have made a booking and subsequently are unable to attend, please cancel your booking to make the place available for someone else. - If you have not been able to get a booking for one of the services, please try back on the Reservations Page later, since a cancellation may have become available.
- All the service listed below will be live streamed, so if you are unable to participate in the Church for any reason, you can still tune in through the internet.

- Night Prayer at 10.00 pm (live stream only)

## Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> April (Good Friday)

- Morning Prayer at 10.00 am (live stream only)
- Confessions after Morning Prayer until 11.30 am
- Liturgy of the Passion at 3.00 pm
- Stations of the Cross at 7.00 pm with 50 people  
*Traditionally on Good Friday a collection is taken up for 'Holy Places', to support Christians in the Holy Land. These Holy Places have suffered greatly during the pandemic and you are invited to make an offering, if you can using the white tubs in the Church)*

- Morning Prayer at 10.00 am (live stream only)
- Confessions after Morning Prayer until 11.30 am
- Easter Vigil at 8.00 pm

## Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> April (Easter Sunday)

- Masses at 9.00am, 10.30am, 12noon

## Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April

- Mass at 12 noon

This is to allow us to accommodate funerals without having to cancel existing Mass Bookings. 


