## At the Heart of Hope – Piano Recital

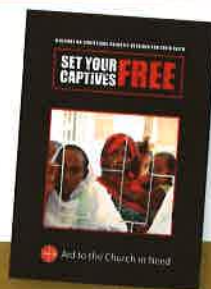
Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November • 7pm – 9pm • Livestream
