We understand that our decision to open or close schools for bad weather has a substantial effect on families. We also understand that our students are better served by being in school. But as always, our top priority is the safety of our students, faculty, and staff.

The Catholic schools in Jackson, Harrison, Hancock, and Pearl River counties will be closed on Tuesday, September 15, in anticipation of tropical storm or hurricane force winds, rain, and flooding. There will be no virtual learning or in-person learning on this day. A decision regarding further closures will be made as soon as possible and will be communicated through your principal. This decision has to be made far enough in advance to give families time to plan for children being out of school. For those of us that have been through many tropical systems, we know how unpredictable they are and know that we could wake up Tuesday morning to beautiful, sunny skies. We hope that is what happens. If it does, say a prayer to thank our Lord that we have been spared and enjoy your day. If we get the predicted bad weather, stay safe and know that our prayers are with you.
