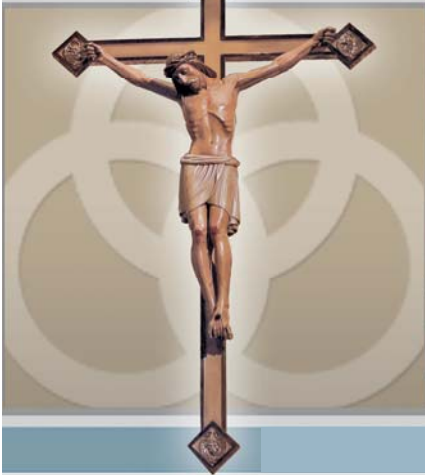

## February 8, 2020 - World Day of Prayer, Reflection and Action Against Human Trafficking

Human trafficking is a crime in which force, fraud or coercion is used to compel a person to perform labor, services or commercial sex. It affects all populations: adults, children, men, women, foreign nationals and U.S. citizens, and all economic classes.

The Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace and the International Union of Superiors General has designated February 8 as an annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. February 8 is the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. Once Josephine was freed, she became a Canossian nun and dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery as well as comforting the poor and suffering. She was declared a Saint in 2000.

On February 8, Catholics all over the world are encouraged to pray to create greater awareness about this phenomenon. Through prayer, we not only reflect on the experiences of those that have suffered through this affront to human dignity, but also comfort, strengthen, and help empower survivors.

### Prayer to St. Josephine Bakhita

St. Josephine Bakhita, you were sold into slavery as a child and endured untold hardship and suffering. Once liberated from your physical enslavement, you found true redemption in your encounter with Christ and his church. O St. Bakhita, assist all those who are trapped in a state of slavery; intercede with God on their behalf so that they will be released from their chains of captivity. Those whom man enslaves, let God set free. Provide comfort to survivors of slavery and let them look to you as an example of hope and faith. Help all survivors find healing from their wounds. We ask for your prayers and intercessions for those enslaved among us. Amen.

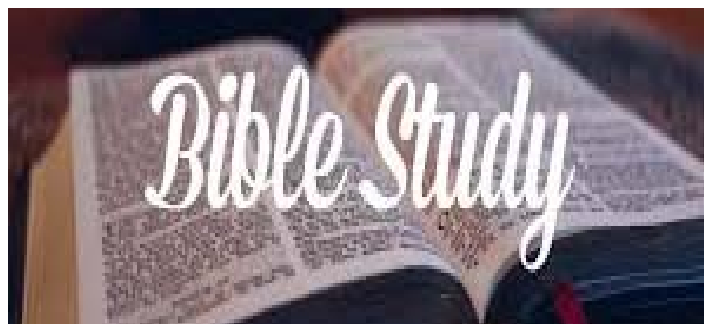

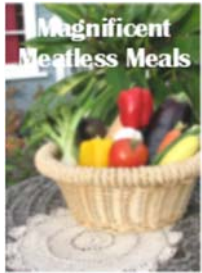

In the state of California, anyone who has engaged in sexual misconduct with a child under the age of 16 is not allowed to work directly with minors, or to be unaccompanied with minors. This includes volunteer and employee positions. This law helps to create safe environments for our children in our schools and churches. #### Scripture Focus:

Jesus certainly believed that the Law of Moses was connected to the reign of God he came to announce. He tells his followers that he came not to abolish but to fulfill the Law, meaning that his message demanded that people go beyond the letter of the Law to the spirit behind it. Christian life beyond the Law was more, not less, demanding than a strict keeping of each little rule of the Law. Jesus promised that the spirit of the Law would lead the people to the fullness of the reign of God.

#### Reflection:

1. Remember an experience when keeping "just the letter of the law" was not enough for you.
2. Relate an experience when rules and regulations began as an obstacle but became an opportunity to grow in faith.
3. Name an experience when you broke from what was expected of you.

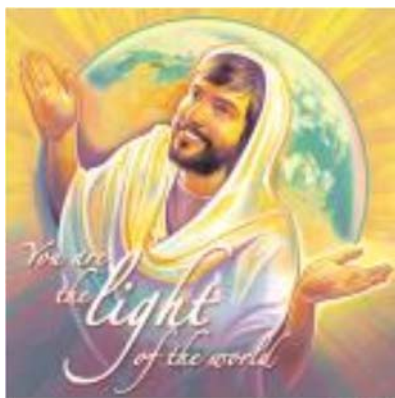
