

Junior Church History Class Rules for 2014 - 2015.

1. Be in the classroom before the bell rings or receive a demerit.
2. Stand silently at your desk and be ready to pray.
3. Things not allowed in the classroom: food, disposable water bottles, computers, cell phones.
4. Keep your feet on the floor and your hands to yourself.
5. NO outward signs of affection.
6. Bathroom breaks are at teacher's discretion.
7. Cell phones, computers, etc. are not to be used or seen in class. (See # 3)
8. The uniform rules will be enforced. Purchase the proper cold weather gear before it gets cold.
9. Discipline rubrics: First: The teacher will initiate a 'Verbal Warning/Request.' Second: the teacher will request the student's Demerit Card. Third: If the student does not have the demerit card and/or back-talks or disrespects the teacher at this time then the student will be sent to See Mr. Lee. If the matter warrants severe disciplinary action, the teacher will either send or take the student to see Mr. Lee.
10. Your student planner is your hall pass. If you don't have the planner and you 'must' leave the room, you will be eligible for a demerit. Note: have your planner filled out with destination on the proper calendar date. The teacher will write in the time and initial the pass. You have five minutes to get back to class for toilet breaks. Two people may not use the same pass.
10. b. Only one person may leave the room at any given time to use the restroom.
11. If a teacher needs you to come see them during my class time (this includes study hall period), they must issue an official pass or write the request on the proper calendar day in your planner. You will not be allowed to leave without preauthorization from a teacher. One exception is if you need to go to study hall or seminar due to being on the "Incomplete List" or the "D/F List."
12. Study hall is for study, not for talking. Be quiet.
13. Stand and pray at the opening and closing of school. Also, recite the pledge of allegiance. Stand in a properly ordered stance for prayer and pledge.
14. If the teacher allows the students to work in groups, the groups will talk in a 'hushed' tone. No hollering across the classroom.
15. The teacher will dismiss you from class; therefore, remain in or at your seats until dismissed. Pick up your trash and and personal items.
16. Stay out of the teacher's personal chairs, and do not touch his possessions.
17. The students will have their shirts tucked in while in the classroom.
18. Each student needs to have appropriate clothing for cooler weather; that is, you will need to procure garments that meet school dress code before it gets cool/cold. Also, you need to have those cool weather garments in your possession when it is cool/cold. You will be not allowed to wear any unapproved garments in class even if it is, in your opinion, "freezing."
19. Be reverent, quiet and respectful at Mass and remove chewing gum.
20. Do not talk through the classroom windows to those persons standing outside in the parking lot.
21. Violation of these rules can result in disciplinary action pursuant to the rules of St. Pius X

High School.
