Course Description

This is a year-long course that serves as an introduction to choral music, both sacred and secular. The core curriculum emphasizes the basics of vocal technique and health, learning to sing in parts, an introduction to acoustics, basic music theory, and some music history. There are two required performances for this ensemble; one will be in December and the second will be at the end of the spring semester.
