Financial Bullet Points on the Former St. Benedict the Moor Parish and the New St. Benedict the Moor Personal Parish

- Fall of 2019, the Diocese of Pittsburgh established Epiphany as the lead parish for the newly formed Divine Mercy Parish – meaning the new parish Divine Mercy for continuity purposes would use the operating checking account and Employee Identification Number (EIN) of Epiphany – thus in December 2019 all expenses for Epiphany, St. Benedict the Moor and St. Mary the Point were paid out of Epiphany’s operating checking account
- January 2020 Divine Mercy Parish began, and Divine Mercy Parish assumed all the assets and liabilities of the predecessor parishes
- In exercising its ministries, Divine Mercy Parish operated for over six months using the funds on hand and collected from parishioners and used the funds to maintain the parishes buildings, staff and other operational requirements
- In July when the new St. Benedict the Moor “personal parish” was established, the Diocese of Pittsburgh gave \$100,000 to begin operations
- Additionally, savings balance from the Capital Improvement Fund and Church Alive Campaign, as well as the buildings/land assets of the former St. Benedict the Moor parish was given back to the newly formed St. Benedict the Moor personal parish
